TIE IT DOWN

Have you ever been transporting your bike by trailer or truck and found yourself clenching your teeth around every turn and over every bump? Well, it's time to relax. Gator straps will put your tip-over worries to rest. These straps are

monsters! They are a full 10% thicker than conventional tie downs, come in 1 and 1 1/2 inch widths, and are a generous 7 feet in length. Gator straps are available in the familiar cam buckle style or in a heavy duty ratchet model. Every strap has bonded seams to eliminate fraying and they are double box stitched for an assembly strength of up to 2000 pounds. Probably the best feature is the inverted design with built-in soft loops. These loops are positioned away from the buckles so all the hard parts and extra strap lengths are away from your shiny painted parts. The soft loops can also be used to link straps together to make a single 12-foot length.

HUD

"OK, Maverick, go to guns; you're clear to splash the Mig!"

We're having some fun at M-E with the SportVue MC1 Heads Up Display (HUD), the world's first HUD for motorcycles.

Information such as speed, rpm, and gear selection are projected as a clear and finely tunable image through a streamlined, wireless helmet-mounted display (HMD). The HMD receives this data from a small motorcycle sending

unit (MSU) that can be wired into just about any motorcycle. Speed is sensed by a simple magnetic interrupter which is fastened to the rear sprocket or brake disc. This interrupter passes by a stationary pickup

that can be mounted to any convenient location like the swingarm or rear brake caliper.

The rpm is tapped from the cam or crank sensor wiring using Quick-tab connectors that pierce the bike wiring without damage. There is no cutting, splicing, or soldering reguired. Gear positions are "taught" to the MSU by slowly rolling the throttle through each gear while the bike is supported by a sturdy tail stand. The HMD will tell you when to shift to the next gear and it will learn up to 6 gears.

We mounted our MC1 on a Ducati 900FE. It took a bit longer than the 2 hour advertised installation time, but this was due to our desire to have the MSU and wire loom mounted and routed like it was the Space Shuttle. The installation is actually pretty straightforward. SportVue's

MC1 includes everything, and we mean everything, to outfit one motorcycle and one helmet.

If you feel like an F-18 pilot, the MC1 will let you attack your favorite road and keep your eyes on the target while real time info is in the corner of your eye. It works remarkably well, isn't as distractive as you would think and you'll get a lot of attention from the Do some recon at bogies you strafe. www.sportvue.com.
